Other Notes

Weather: With the change in weather it is very important that students are dressed appropriately. With the temperatures hovering around the freezing point students need to have jackets, gloves/mittens and hats. Students that are not dressed for the weather will be kept inside. Additionally, snow season can start at any time. Students will need to have boots in order to play outside and off the blacktop. Please be sure your child has the appropriate footwear for the weather too. We want your children to be safe based on weather conditions and ask your help in making sure they are prepared.

Office: Over the summer months the Elementary office was moved from the 2nd floor to downstairs and is now co-joined with the Middle/High School office. We’ve noticed some of you who are less frequent visitors may not have noticed that change. The elementary secretary’s office (Robin Volkmann) is the first door inside the main entrance, Room 109. The Middle/High School secretary’s office (Amy Lautenbach) was shifted over to the right (Room 108). Pupil Service/Special Ed office (Sue Anschutz), was moved upstairs to Room 210. If you need any assistance during school hours, you must check in with the office first.

Packers Day – With the Packers playing Seattle on Thursday Night Football (November 15), that Thursday will be a Packers Day – wear your favorite Packers T-shirt or jersey.



Attendance: A reminder that you can use PowerSchool to review your child's attendance. Remember that a child can be excused by a parent no more than 10 days per school year as per Board Policy outlined in the student handbook.

Also, Parents have in the past contacted (in some cases) the teacher directly – with a note, a call an email – stating that there is an upcoming vacation, a doctor's appointment, etc. These notices should be going through the office. The office will be sure to notify the classroom teacher.
