A *Learning Support Center* is being sponsored by the *new* Boys and Girls Club of Door County (BGDC) in cooperation with Sevastopol School that will provide an additional daytime setting for Sevastopol students to complete schoolwork or participate in programs and activities when they have down time. Beginning Monday, January 25, the ballroom at the Institute Saloon will provide a positive learning environment for up to 24 students and allow for social distancing on days that they are normally not at school. Programming Details

- Monday-Friday beginning January 25
- Half day or full day commitments are available.
- 7:30 AM to 3:45 PM (4:00 latest pick-up)
- Located at 4599 WI-57, Sturgeon Bay—parents are responsible for drop-off and pick-up at the back of the building.
- Students are responsible for lunch or if unavailable, Sevastopol School will provide.

Program Activities

- Academics: Sevastopol teachers will provide academic work. BGDC staff will have access to teacher emails and Google classrooms (if appropriate).
- Art-Mrs. Krueger-- Google classroom (tool to access)
- Music- Ms. Angelo-- Google classroom (tool to access)
- Physical Education/movement- combination of BGDC activities and Mrs. Wiesner's Google classroom (tool to access)
- STEM- BGDC to coordinate
- Games- BGDC to coordinate
- Outside activities are subject to proper supervision and will be held in a designated area behind the Saloon.

Enrollment Progress

- Open to registered Sevastopol students in grades K-8
- Families should complete a Boys and Girls Club application with enrollment fees returned to BGDC.
- Boys and Girls Club personnel will notify families of acceptance.
